Designed by the legendary Oliver D. North, the 'Mechanical Horse' was introduced in 1934, largely in response to the need of the railway companies for a motorised vehicle to replace horse-drawn carriages. As a working vehicle, it offered a number of important advantages: its wooden cab cut down on unloaded weight, it could automatically couple and de-couple with trailers, and its single front wheel turned through 360°, making the 'Horse' exceptionally manoeuvrable. In the late 1940s the 'Horse' was redesigned to create the Scarab.

Both Continental and Japanese car makers were eating into the British market with vastly better specifications. Dagenham's answer was the MkIII. During its production life it received several upgrades and by the time it was discontinued in September 1976, it had sold an astonishing 1.1 million models.

C Royal Navy Signaller with Flags - Battle of Trafalgar "England expects every man will do his duty." The most famous signal in our history was hoisted as the English fleet closed with the combined French and Spanish fleets off Cape Trafalgar on the 21st October 1805.
